With **Haiti's current chaos**, many of you have asked, "What can I do?" and "How can I help?"

Here are 3 ways that you can help...

1) Immediate need: Fast and pray

Life has become very difficult in Haiti, so prayer is the priority! Today and next Monday (Nov. 4 and Nov. 11) join us in fasting over lunch and fervently praying for our brothers and sisters in Haiti.

2) Short term: Sustain ministry in Haiti

Since Lifeline's inception, mission trips have been a funding source for ministry on the ground. Each time a mission trip participant serves with us, a part of the trip donation pays for the pastors, leaders, and overall ministries.

Unfortunately, the chaos in Haiti has disrupted mission trips and our teams to Haiti have dropped by 50% in 2019 and by at least 50% in 2020. Fortunately many 2019 teams diverted to other locations. However this fall and looking into 2020, there is a lack of donations from trips to maintain the current staff and ministry.


Lifeline is facing a funding gap of about \$30,000 per month every month that teams do not travel to Haiti. This is a huge stress on Lifeline's overall ministry budget. Until the Haiti situation improves, the ministry feels the impact daily.

Could you donate and/or raise donations from your family/friends to assist with the ministry?

3) Long term: Fund solar panels

Due to the turbulence and the Haitian economy, the cost of fuel has skyrocketed, and it is hard to obtain. Therefore, our ministries in Grand-Goâve and Port-au-Prince are forced to ration the use of our generators to produce our power. If these campuses had solar panels, they would not be relying on fuel for power. The solar panels would provide power for the water pump, the administration offices, the clinic, the children's home, and the mission houses.
