Our hope is that this initiative will fulfill our mission to see lives transformed through the Gospel. Pray for creative ideas, a clear presentation, and for it to be far-reaching among our former campers.
3. **FULL TIME STAFF MORALE** - It is interesting to see our team and watch them as they navigate the stress that comes with COVID, grief of not having summer camp, uncertainty about the fall, etc. There are up days and down days. Please pray for this amazing group of people that we consider family. I am so proud of them and thankful that they are working here at SABC.
4. **SUMMER STAFF TEAM** - as you are aware, we were able to hire 8 summer staff on a CSJ Grant. They have been working on various projects and we are thankful to have them here. Pray God would stretch them and mold them to be more like Him.
5. **PAUSING DAVE'S MEALS** - For 3 weeks in July we are pausing the operation of Dave's Meals to give our staff a rest as well as prepare for a benevolent program that will allow us to give meals away to families and individuals affected by the COVID crisis. We have been given a grant to supply meals for those in need. Pray that we will be able to communicate this well with our constituents and churches. Pray that this will be well received and will meet the needs of people in our greater community.

6. **FINANCES** - We are keeping our heads above water but there are significant concerns as we look ahead to the fall. Many of our groups have cancelled their retreats. We are considering our options but really need some help and wisdom in making good decisions. RFAR cycling fundraiser was an amazing success and there have been a few government programs that we have been able to access.

7. **DECISIONS DECISIONS** -- Part of this journey is adjusting to constant changes in guidelines. Pray that we would have wisdom as we navigate these times.
