Prayer Requests

1. Camp4U - We are wrapping this online video series up by August 14. It has been well received and there are links for kids to enjoy it over the next year if they want. Thankful for our great staff team to be able to put this together. Pray that kids would be encouraged in their faith. Pray that the message of “Setting our Sights” might cause the listener to make changes in their lives to live for Christ.
2. SABC Volunteer Work Week (Aug 17-20) - There are some projects that need to be finished or completed before the fall. They include new shingles on a number of different buildings, finishing the washhouse project, staining, cleaning the brand new addition, and helping in the kitchen. Pray that we would find people to help during this time and that we can get most things done.
3. Fort Cohort - Our summer staff will be leaving the middle of August. They are each going to different situations and for some there is a lot of uncertainty about next steps. Please pray for Christy, Rachel, Amy, Cassandra, Will, Jamey, Dakota, and Darian. Some of them have graduated from college or university and are looking for work. Others are going back to school. We have been honored to have these talented people working here for the past 8 weeks and look forward to seeing what God will do in and through them over the coming years.
4. Dave’s Meals - ON THE HOUSE! - We’ve relaunched Dave’s meals and have added Dave’s meals ON THE HOUSE! This is a program designed to provide meals for people that have been adversely affected by the COVID pandemic. Examples of people we have been able to help include a couple where one spouse has a serious autoimmune deficiency and the other has chosen not to work but to care for her. Another couple is older and has been completely isolated from the rest of their community. There are many more examples of this. Our goal is to give away at least 30 meal packages per week. Pray that we can communicate effectively with our churches and others in the camp network to get these meals to those that need it most! Pray for the recipients of these meals that through meeting this practical need that people might be encouraged and feel loved by their neighbors and the local church.
5. Building Project - Still not completed but work is progressing and we are hoping that it won’t be too much longer. Pray for Silver Ridge Construction and their team to take care of all of the remaining details. Pray that it would still remain under budget. Pray that there would not be any surprises at the end!

6. Fall Direction - There is a huge amount of uncertainty with respect to the fall. Pray that our staff would have wisdom in making decisions and seeking out solutions for staying afloat in the case that we are unable to host retreats. Please also pray fervently that we would be able to run camp in 2021.
